WHAT IS IT?

Process that gives the college the authority to make adjustments, on a case-by-case basis, to information reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) so that the Department of Education can recalculate the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).



WHO SHOULD PURSUE **PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENT?**

Students whose household has experienced changes in income or other finances that are not reflected in their information from two years prior.

Examples include: changes in a family's reported income, death or disability of a wage earner, separation/divorce of the student's parents
