TITLE: Development and Operation of Student Groups

DATE ADOPTED: November 2, 2018

EFFECTIVE DATE: November 2, 2018

SUPERSEDES: October 15, 1992

PURPOSE:

The College encourages the development and responsible operation of all student groups including, but not limited to clubs, organizations, and honor societies which have purposes consistent with the philosophy and mission of the College, are relevant to the community they serve, and demonstrate compliance with all applicable laws.

POLICY:

Membership in student groups is open to all registered Rowan College at Burlington County students in good academic standing. Some honor societies may have stipulated requirements for membership which must receive approval of the College prior to implementation.

Any discrimination is expressly and strictly prohibited as a basis for denying a student in good academic standing membership or participation in any aspect of the operation of a student group. The Board directs the chief enrollment/student affairs officer or designee to establish and implement appropriate procedures and processes regulating student groups.
