Full-Time Scholars (12+ credits)		
Tier 1 (Maximum)	\$800	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Successful completion of PCLI (first-time, first-year students) Continuing scholars with a GPA 3.0 or higher & high engagement May be increased or decreased after the initial semester based on GPA and/or engagement with EOF programming
Tier 2 (Standard)	\$600	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Default award for new students entering the program and continuing scholars with a GPA of 2.5 or higher Moderate engagement May be increased or decreased after the initial semester based on GPA and/or engagement with EOF programming
Tier 3 (Below Standard)	\$400	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> GPA below 2.5 and/or minimal to no engagement May be increased or decreased after the initial semester based on GPA and/or engagement with EOF programming
Part-Time Scholars (6-11 credits)		
Tier 4 (Standard)	\$513	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Making academic progress with a GPA of 2.5 or higher May be increased or decreased after the initial semester based on GPA and/or engagement with EOF programming
Tier 5 (Below Standard)	\$300	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> GPA below 2.5 Minimal to no engagement with EOF programming May be increased or decreased after the initial semester based on GPA and/or engagement with EOF programming
Non-Funded		
Tier 6 (Non-Funded)	\$0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On SAP but received an EOF grant in the past Reached maximum # of part-time awards but still wants/needs support from EOF No engagement with EOF programming

How to earn Engagement Points

Meet with an EOF Advisor each month, attend EOF town halls, and 2 educational workshops.

20 points each	10 points each	10 points each
