Board Chair, Mr. Sean Kennedy, called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

The first items of business were the flag salute, Ms. Snyder read the roll call of the Trustees, and recited the Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

The next item of business was a motion for the Board to enter into Executive Session with the College's Conflict of Interest Solicitor, Mr. Steven Edelstein, Esq. from Weiner Law Group to discuss legal matters that fall within attorney-client privilege. Mr. Kennedy asked for a roll call to approve Resolution 2026-01-01A, for the Board to convene in Executive Session, and was unanimously approved. Mr. Kennedy stated that any formal action resulting from Executive Session discussions will be taken in open session. At this time, staff, faculty, and any other public guests left the meeting.

The Board reconvened in Open Session at 6:00 pm Upon return to Open Session, Trustee Braddock moved to approve Resolution 2026-01-02A, as discussed in Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Trustee White. Upon roll call vote, the motion passed unanimously by a vote of 8:1.

At this time, the Chair, Mr. Kennedy, opened the floor for public comment in accordance with Board policy. There were no requests to speak, and public comment was closed.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
