Chair Mr. Sean Kennedy called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

The first items of business were the flag salute, Ms. Ashley Pezzolla reading the roll call of the Trustees, and Ms. Snyder reciting the Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

The next item of business was the College's President's Report. Dr. David Spang, Acting President for the College, provided an update on college operations, including the recent visit from Ms. Kathy Feith and Dr. David Rehm, from the Commission Liaison Guided Visit ("GLGV"), on behalf of the Middle States Commission on Higher Education ("MSCHE") on January 16, 2026, who provided met with each of the Board Committees, Executive Staff and selected members of the College to provide valuable insight and constructive feedback on the College's progress toward demonstrating compliance with Standards II - Ethics & Integrity, and VII - Governance, Leadership, and Administration. Dr. Spang expressed his appreciation to the faculty, staff, students, Trustees, and administrators whose efforts helped make the CLGV meetings a success. No formal Board action was required.

The next item of business was the approval of the following three (3) Finance and Facilities Committee Resolutions, presented by Committee Chair Mr. Thomas Braddock:

- **TAB 1:** To approve and/or ratify requested business-related travel.
- **TAB 2:** To approve and/or ratify certain agreements and contracts.

- **TAB 3:** To award a contract with **Strober-Wright Roofing, Inc.** for the Evans Hall Roof Replacement Project on the Mt. Laurel Campus, in the amount of **\$1,363.613.00**.

There was a motion by Dr. Darvis Holley and a second by Ms. Jannine Veasey. Upon a roll call vote, the motions passed unanimously.

The next item of business was the approval of the following Personnel Committee Resolution, presented by Committee Chair Mr. Kevin Brown:

- **TAB 4:** To approve and/or ratify personnel actions for Rowan College at Burlington County.

There was a motion by Mr. Dorion Morgan and a second by Mr. Thomas Braddock. Upon roll call vote, the motion passed unanimously.

The next item of business was the approval of the following Academic Committee Resolution presented by Committee Chair Dr. Darvis Holley:

- **TAB 5:** Approval to enter into a **Partnership with Willingboro School District** to increase dual enrollment opportunities.

There was a motion by Ms. Nina Bonner and a second by Mr. Kevin Brown. Upon roll call vote, the motion passed unanimously.

The next item of business was Board Chair Kennedy appointing three of the Trustees to the College's newly formed Board Policy Review Committee, along with selected members of the President's Executive Staff, to review, update, and amend the College's Board Policies. Chair Kennedy nominated Messrs. Thomas Braddock, Curtis White, along with himself to reside on the Committee.

At this time, Board Chair Kennedy moved to table the proposed revisions of the College's Bylaws under TAB 7 - Resolution to amend the Bylaws of Rowan College at Burlington County: Article 3 Board Organization, Section 3.7 Duties of the Secretary, to allow for further review and consideration. The motion was seconded by Trustee Brown and carried a unanimous vote from the Board. The item will be brought back at a future meeting for review and approval.

The final item to be discussed was the approval of the following Board Policy, presented by Mr. Thomas Braddock:

- **TAB 6:** Adoption / Affirmation of certain Board Policies
 - **Policy No. 900** - Development, Review, and Maintenance of Board Policies and Administrative Procedures

There was a motion by Dr. Darvis Holley and a second by Ms. Jannine Veasey. Upon roll call vote, the motions passed unanimously.
