## PROGRAM FEATURES

### **CREDIT DEGREES AND CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS:**

Successful completion of these courses will lead to an associate degree or credit certificate that may be transferred to a higher degree. For more information, please visit [rcbc.edu/degrees](http://rcbc.edu/degrees).

### **NON-CREDIT COURSES:**

These courses are short, one-time completion certificates. Upon completion of each course, the student receives a pass/fail grade - not numerical. ### **3+1 PROGRAM:**

This is a premier partnership with Rowan University that allows students to take 75% of their courses (up to their junior year) at RCBC's tuition rate and complete their last year on RCBC's Mount Laurel Campus or online through Rowan University. This allows students to receive an associate and bachelor's degree for the price most college students spend in a single year. Please note: only certain programs qualify. ### **IN-COUNTY TUITION:**

### **TUITION REIMBURSEMENT:**

This payment method is used when an employer pays the student directly following the completion of the semester. This typically only covers tuition costs - not fees, books, and other materials.

### **THIRD PARTY BILLING:**

This is payment issued by an employer directly to the college after the completion of the semester. This usually only covers tuition costs - not fees, books and other materials. The college cannot provide grades or bills to the employer; these documents must come directly from the student.
