RCBC 2021



3+1 Program

RCBC's premier partnership with Rowan University offers students a path to a bachelor's degree that saves them up to \$75,000.

Students complete 75% of their credits at RCBC before completing their senior year as a university student in Mount Laurel or online.

Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)

The Educational Opportunity Fund program provides academic, financial and personal support to students from low socio-economic backgrounds who exhibit potential for academic success. If you are a New Jersey resident who has earned a high school diploma or its equivalent, are interested in attending college and meet the financial guidelines, you may be eligible for acceptance to the EOF program.

The New Jersey Student Tuition Assistance Reward Scholarship (NJ STARS), is a merit-based scholarship exclusively for New Jersey residents identified in the top 15% of their high school class in their junior or senior year.
