## Nursing Program Quick Facts:

### Admissions Process:

Admission to RCBC's Nursing program is competitive and based primarily on an admission rubric. The grades of each pre-requisite course is factored into the chart and averaged for a total score, based off of each attempt if a student failed the first attempt. If a student passed a course with a C or better and retakes it, the highest score is utilized.

*For example; if a student receives a C+ in PSY 101, retakes it, and then earns an A, the A is used on the rubric. If a student receives a D and repeats for a C+, the two scores are averaged.*

- Achievement of a *cumulative* grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 or greater in all college coursework.
- Students with non-repeated *failures* in prerequisite (non-nursing) courses are not admissible until the failure is repeated. Science courses can be no more than 8 years old.
- Students with more than 2 failures and more than 2 repeats of the required courses are not being admitted at this time. Failures 8 years old or more are not considered in the rubric.
- LPN students must meet the same admissions criteria.
- To apply for the Nursing program, complete an online application-See the website for dates.
