TITLE: Admissions Policy
ADOPTED: November 2, 2018
EFFECTIVE DATE: November 2, 2018
SUPERSEDES: July 16, 1968

PURPOSE:

This policy defines the admissions policy for all students (full-time, part-time and visiting students) seeking admissions into a degree or certification program with Rowan College at Burlington County (“RCBC”).

POLICY:

RCBC has an Open Enrollment Policy.

RCBC’s academic, professional and cultural opportunities are accessible without regard to race, color, national origin, sex or disability.

Students who have completed their high school diploma or equivalent or who are otherwise determined to have an ability to benefit from post-secondary education are permitted to begin their study with RCBC.

The Board directs the chief enrollment/student affairs officer or designee to establish procedures for admission to the institution, including for those students seeking F-1 visa status from the College. The chief enrollment/student affairs officer and academic officer/provost or their



designees are hereby directed to determine eligibility and application procedures for selective programs, including but not limited to, health sciences programs.
