Men between the ages of 18 through 25 are required to register with the Selective Service System. This requirement applies to all male U. S. citizens and male non-citizens, with only a few exceptions. Please review the requirements on the Selective Service website at www.sss.gov for detailed information on this requirement.

Male students who have not registered with the Selective Service will not be considered eligible for financial aid without a valid reason for not registering.

- I am/was a noncitizen who first entered the U.S. after I turned 26.
- I am/was a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as lawful nonimmigrants on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after they turned 26.
- I am a transgender male who was assigned the sex of female at birth.
- I have not registered for a reason not listed above.
